# Terms of publication in the journal "Herald of Cardiovascular Surgery"

The "Herald of Cardiovascular Surgery" journal is included in the list of scientific editions of Ukraine, which can publish the results of PhD thesis in order to obtain the degree of doctor of sciences and PhD degree (approved by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine from  $06.03.2015 \, \mathbb{N} \, 261$ ).

#### **General requirements**

The articles in the journal paper are published in the original language: Ukrainian, English or Russian. On the journal's website the articles must be published in English.

Besides the text, the authors should submit:

- UDC(universal decimal classification) of the article; names and initials of authors; name of the institution where the authors work (if there are several authors and they work in different places, the institutions must be identified by icons 1, 2, 3); city and country (for foreigners);
  - illustrations;
- list of references, in which at least 50% of the sources were published in the past five years;
- summary of the article with the full title, surnames and initials of the authors, name of the institution where the authors work, key words (from 3 to 7 words or phrases that reveal the content of the article) in three languages: Ukrainian, Russian and English (the translation must be of high quality and identical to the original text, the name of the institution must be the same as the official name). The text of the summary should have the same structure as the article, including: "Introduction", "Objective", "Materials and Methods", "Results and Discussion", "Conclusions". Summary length: up to 1500 characters;
- the full article in English for its publication on the journal's website <a href="http://cvs-herald.org.ua">http://cvs-herald.org.ua</a> (the translation must be of high quality and identical to the original text);
- postal and email address, telephone number, academic degree, academic rank, position of one of the authors who is responsible for the correspondence for publication in the journal.
- letter from the head of the institution where the author(s) work(s) concerning the publication of the article/articles directed to the chief editor of the journal;
- for PhD postgraduate students and PhD applicants a written review by the PhD supervisor or doctor of sciences in their specialty.

Additionally, the next information must be submitted in three languages: name, surname, middle name of all authors; names of institutions, in which the authors work, and their corresponding cities; scientific degrees, ranks, positions; contact details.

ATTENTION! The names are not corrected; they are published according to the author's edition.

The signatures of all authors are needed in a collective article.

All articles received by the editorial board, are subjected to peer review and edited in accordance with the terms of the publication in the journal. If necessary, the article may be returned to authors for revision and response of questions. Proofreading is not sent to the authors, all prepress is conducted by the editorial office according to original copyright. Rejected manuscripts are not returned.

Already published articles or articles submitted to other publications are not accepted for publication.

#### Requirements for the text of the article

The structure of the article's main text must correspond to generally accepted structure for scientific papers and consist of the following sections: "Introduction," "Objective", "Materials and Methods", "Results and Discussion", "Conclusions".

Publications should include these essential elements: a general problem formulation and its connection with important scientific or practical concerns; analysis of recent researches and publications which reveal possible solution of this problem and which act as a reference for the article, conception of the unsolved aspects of the problem, which the article covers; the formulation of article's objectives; presentation of the main research material with full justification of scientific results; the findings from this study and the perspectives for further research in this direction.

The summary of the article, which contains the results of experimental studies, must have similar structure.

If the article contains a description of experiments on animals, it should be clarified if the method of their implementation corresponds to the Helsinki Declaration of 1975 and its review in 1983, and if the methods of anesthesia and animal life deprivation are in accordance with the "Rules of work with animals experiments", approved by the Order of the Ministry of Health of Ukraine.

Bibliographic description of article's references is presented according to the standard "Bibliographic description of the document" (State Standards of Ukraine 7.1:2006 "System of standards on information, librarianship and publishing. Bibliographic record. Bibliographic description. General requirements and rules.").

### **Examples:**

a) for articles in periodicals: surname and initials of the author(s), article's title, journal's title, year of publication, issue, pages.

Britskaya N. Surgical treatment of patients with necrotizing pancreatitis in the phase of purulent detachment / N.N. Britskaya // Clinical Surgery. - 2012. - № 8. - P. 49-51. (*If there are not more than three authors*)

Experience of 400 kidney transplantations / V.K. Denisov, P.S. Sernyak, V.V. Zakharov [et al.] // Transplantology. - 2000. - № 1. - P. 146-147. (If there are four or more authors)

- **b) for monographs:** *surname and initials of the author(s), monograph's title, name of the city of publication, name of publisher, year of publication, pages.*
- Sitar L.L. Thoracic aortic aneurysms (clinical findings, diagnostics, treatment): Monograph / L.L. Sitar. Ternopol, 2011. 168 p.
- **c) for compilations:** *surnames and initials of the author(s), name of the work, collection's title, name of the city of publication, year of publication, pages.*
- Girin L.V. Prevention of postoperative thromboembolic complications in patients of elderly and senile age after acute cholecystitis operation / L.V. Girin, F.I. Dudenko, I.I. Demchenko // Abstract of Anniversary conference dedicated to 75th anniversary of prof. L.G. Zavgorodniy. Donetsk, 1994. B. 1. P. 146-147.
- **g) for online editions:** main web page, names and initials of the author(s), article's title, reference to the electronic resource and its link.

Availability of information in the modern world [electronic resource] / L.Y. Kostenko, A.O. Chekmarev, A.G. Brovkin, I.A. Pavlusha // Library herald. - 2003. - № 4. - P. 43. - Access to the journal. : http://www.nbuv.gov.ua/articles/2003/03klinko.htm.

Short words and phrases are presented in accordance with State Standards of Ukraine 3582-97 "Abbreviations in the Ukrainian language in the bibliographic description."

The reference lists are compiled in alphabetical order: first the Ukrainian and Russian (Cyrillic) publications, then in other foreign languages (Latin).

## **Technical requirements**

The text is typed in Microsoft Word (any version), font Times New Roman, 14 points at intervals of 1.5, with no tabs, no transfers. All special characters are typed using the "Insert / Symbol" command.

Complicated formulas (like  $H_{\text{max}} = \sqrt{a^2 + b^2} + \Delta H_{\text{max}}$ ) are designed with the equation editor. Simple formulas (such as a + c) can be typed in the text.

Figures, tables, graphs and formulas should be included in the text.

Tables should be built in Microsoft Word. Each table should have a title and a serial number.

Other materials (photographs, drawings, diagrams, charts, graphs, etc.) are designated as "Fig." and are numbered in the order they are mentioned in the article.

Charts and graphs are designed in MS Excel or MS Graph. For the convenience of layout the raw data is added, which is used for the construction and the electronic version.

Illustrations of black and white pictures, executed professionally by hand are allowed. They should be scanned at 300 dpi and sent in TIF or JPG format. While the inscriptions and symbols should be clear and easy to read if the image is decreased in size for the journal column.

Photos, sonograms are submitted in the original or in electronic form, scanned with a resolution of at least 300 dpi and saved in TIFF or JPEG formats.

The reprint of articles is possible only with the written consent of the publisher and with reference to the journal.
